Some facts about Chalmers University and CIT



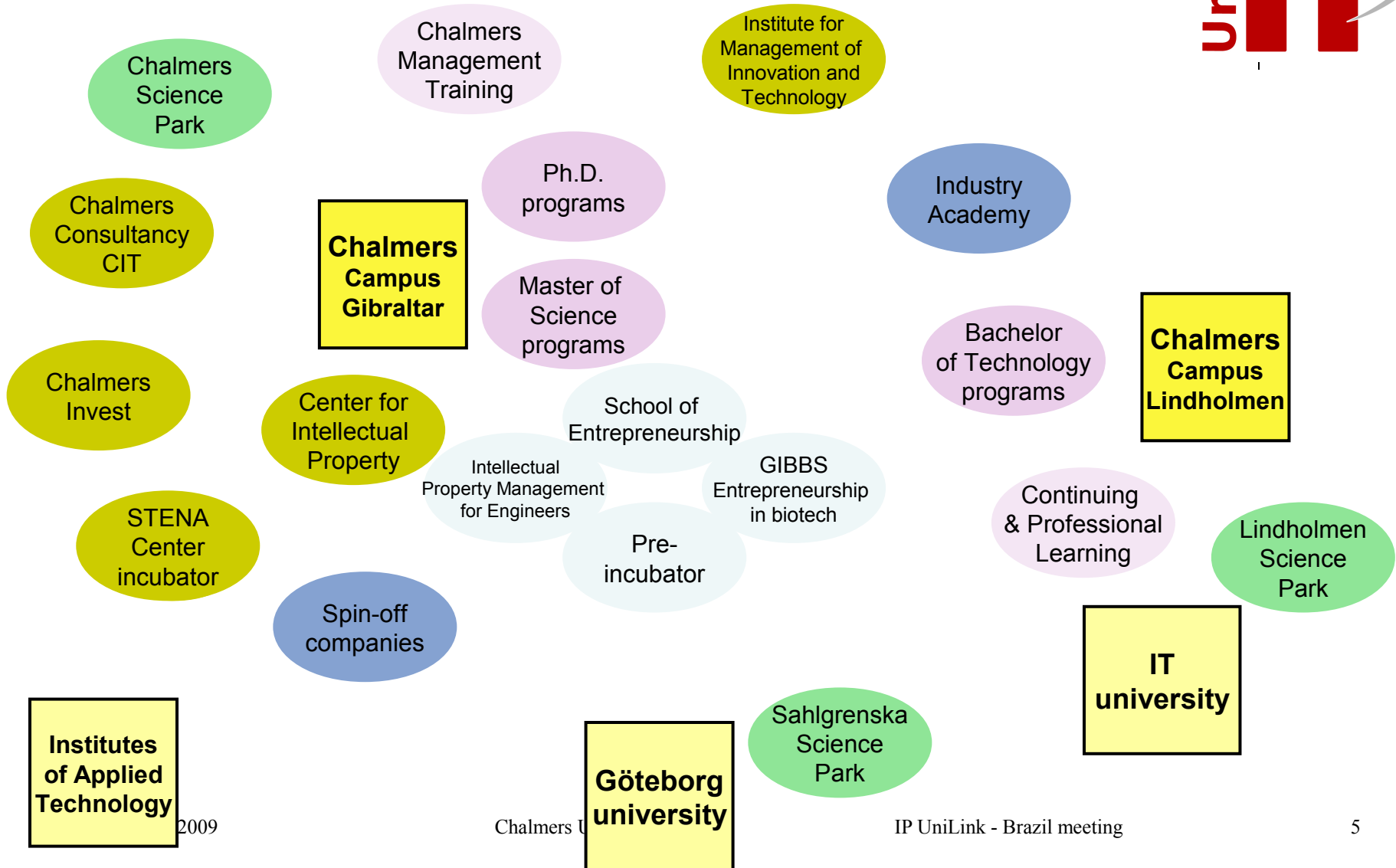
- Chalmers University of Technology is a foundation – and CIT is an independent non-profit R&D foundation

Organisation of Technology Transfer Activities



- CIT is one of many institutions in Chalmers' TT network
- CIT – 62 Employees – 26 with a PhD
- Goal – to enhance University-Industry collaboration
 - Typical customers: Volvo, SAAB, Ericsson, Toyota, etc.
 - But also other projects: ASDI, EU, etc.
- Key numbers
 - 1500 customers – from 49 countries – and 70M€ in revenues generated since the start in 1984
- Intellectual Property Management at the institution
 - Professor's privilege – individual researcher own his results!
